I-READY READING AND MATH

WHAT IS i-READY?

Part 1

i-Ready Reading and Math is a comprehensive assessment and instruction program that empowers educators with the resources they need to help all students succeed.

- → Delivers online lessons that provide tailored instruction and practice for each student to accelerate their learning and growth.
- → Supports teachers with <u>in the moment resources</u> for remediation and reteaching at individualized, small groups, and whole class levels of instruction.
- → Provides user friendly dashboards and clear reports with <u>actionable data</u> that give teachers a foundational understanding of students' strengths and areas of need.
- → Enables educators to confidently determine each students' on-grade level proficiency based on state and national standards.




i-Ready Reading and Math Assessments

- → Takes place 3 times a year (September, January, May) and in between Growth Monitoring (November and March)
- → Illuminates student learning through research-backed measures of performance, including an adaptive Diagnostic, Growth Monitoring, and Standards Mastery.
- → Pinpoint students' strengths and what they need to work on to reach (or exceed) grade-level proficiency.
- → Access an easy-to-use dashboard and robust reports to monitor student growth and inform instruction.
- → Seamlessly connect assessment results to *i-Ready Learning* instructional resources.
- → Assesses 5 different domains in Reading (Phonemic Awareness, Phonics, High Frequency Words, Vocabulary, and Comprehension Literature and Informational Texts).
- → Assesses 4 different domains in Math (Numbers and Operations, Algebra and Algebraic Thinking, Measurement and Data, and Geometry).

WHO DOES i-READY?

i-Ready Reading and Math Lessons:

All students must do i-Ready Reading/Math Lessons except the following:
 Students that are ESOL 1 / Newcomers don't do i-READY Reading Lessons
 These lessons are turned off in the program.

i-Ready Reading/Math Assessments:

- ALL STUDENTS TAKE THE DIAGNOSTIC NO MATTER THEIR LEVEL.
- AP#2 will take place January 10, 2022 through February 4, 2022. Attendance is extremely important.

i-Ready Reading/Math Growth Monitoring:

• All students that are **ONE to TWO GRADE LEVEL BELOW** their actual grade level.

All students complete only 45 minutes a week in each subject.

A participation/effort grade may be given based on the student's usage and passing rate

An academic grade may be given for an "on grade level" Teacher Assigned lesson (bluebutton).

WHY IS i-READY IMPORTANT?

- → It will help your student's teacher(s) determine your student's needs, personalize their learning, and monitor progress throughout the school year.
- → i-Ready allows your child's teacher(s) to meet exactly where they are and provides data to increase your child's learning gains.
- → It is a personalized instruction that provides your child with lessons based on their individual skill level and needs, so your child can learn at a pace that is just right for them.
- → These lessons are fun and interactive to keep your child engaged as they learn.

Winter Recess Home Learning Packet/i-Ready/Imagine Learning

Students must continue their learning and complete home learning assignments

- → Winter Recess Packets **OR** i-Ready teacher assigned lessons.
- → Combination of both: Winter packet sand i-Ready/Imagine Language & Literacy assignments.
- → Students with no devices at home will complete a Winter Recess Packet.
- → Students will be given a grade for the completed Winter Recess Packet as well as the i-Ready Teacher Assigned lessons/Imagine Language & Literacy

WHO DOES IMAGINE LEARNING?

Imagine Language & Literacy

→ Is for ALL ESOL 1 students in grades K-5 (regardless of time in the ESOL program).

Imagine Math

→ Is for ALL **ESOL levels 1-4** in grades K-5.

ALL ESOL students must take the i-Ready reading and math assessments.

IMAGINE LEARNING LESSONS INSTRUCTIONAL USAGE

Imagine Language & Literacy

Usage:

Grades K - 1: 20 minutes/ 3 times per week (minimum)

Grades 2 - 12: 30 minutes/ 3 times per week (minimum)

Weekly Goal: 60 minutes

Yearly Goal: 30 hours

IMAGINE LEARNING LESSONS INSTRUCTIONAL USAGE

Imagine Math

Usage:

Grades K - 2: 20–30 minutes/ 3 times per week 2 lessons completed each week.

Grades 3-5: 60–90 minutes

2–3 lessons per week

WHY IS IMAGINE LEARNING IMPORTANT? Imagine Language & Literacy → Promotes rigorous and equitable development of language that accelerates learning across all subjects.


Imagine Math


